An authorized foreign bank must make the following information available to the public on an annual basis	#
The number of complaints that its Senior Designated Employee dealt with that year, including the number of complaints Resolved or Closed	1
The average length of time the Bank took to deal with those complaints, from the first interaction with the Consumer to the date on which the complaint was Resolved or Closed	1 day
The products or services to which the complaints related	Commercial Ioan
A description of the nature of the complaints, beyond the related product or service information contained in the classification	Unhappiness with fees, pricing or rates
The number of Resolved complaints	1
